29. *Erigeron formosissimus*–Beautiful fleabane (upper leaves small, appressed, ~1 (6) head/stem)
30. *Erigeron speciosus* – Showy Fleabane (leaves even-sized, top hairless, 4-10 heads/stems) (p. 132)
31. *Erigeron subtrinervis* – Three-nerved fleabane (spreading hairs on leaf top, 1-6 heads/stem) (p. 131)
32. *Erigeron vreelanderi* – Broad-leaf fleabane (glangular-sticky stem & leaf top, 1-15 heads/stems)
33. *Erysimum capitatum* – Western Wallflower (orange) (p. 202)
